

Remote Learning strategy for Burgh by Sands School

This information is used as a general guide and parents can expect further details of remote learning for their child as and when it is required. We aim to implement remote learning from your child's second day of absence. There are 2 scenarios outlined below; the first scenario is where you child is not permitted to attend school and the second outlines the actions in the case of a whole bubble not being permitted to attend school.

<p>My child (and their siblings if they are also attending Burgh by Sands School) is absent because they are awaiting test results and our household is required to self-isolate. The rest of their school bubble are attending school and being taught as normal.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maths & English: A set of appropriate workbooks will be provided to your child/ren by the school for English and maths. Your child will be directed by the class teacher to complete certain blocks so the learning at home is mirrored by the learning at school as much as possible.• Additional Maths learning: KS2 children can access My Maths on line. They should already know their log on details.• Additional English learning: KS2 children will be able to access Lexia from home. They should already know their log on details• Phonics sessions for KS1: a list of activities will be sent out to the parentst to be completed during isolation• Topic task: If the lessons being taught in class are not able to be delivered remotely (e.g. it requires specialist resources e.g. clay, atlases etc.) then an alternative "topic" learning will be set which may make use of the Government's "Oak Academy lessons".
<p>My child's whole bubble is not permitted to attend school because they, or another member of their bubble, have tested positive for Covid-19</p> <p>We enter another "lockdown" with total school closure</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reception: Learning tasks for Reception will be set via Tapestry• Maths Lessons: This will be a series of teaching videos from White Rose Maths accompanied by work books/worksheets linked to the lessons. There will also be pre recorded lessons sent via class teachers• English tasks: These will be a series of lessons planned by the class teacher and the Oak National Academy resources will also be used. There will also be worksheets/work books sent home• Topic tasks: These will be sent home to Parents via the class teacher• 1:1 Support: If your child receives 1:1 support and they are isolating, a more bespoke programme of support will be set up. This may include phonecalls/video chats with your child's 1:1 support.• You can contact your child's class teacher via the class email address if you/your child need any support
